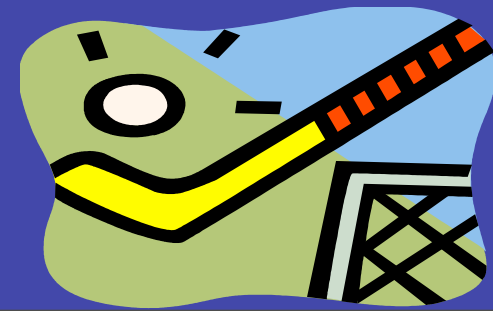

YOUTH TRAVEL HOCKEY FEES

- A recreation card must be purchased
- Residents \$10.00 – Non-Residents \$35.00
- Under 8 years of age – Residents \$140.00
- Under 8 years of age – Non-Residents \$250.00
- 8 years of age or over – Residents \$190.00
- 8 years of age or over – Non-Residents \$450.00
- **2 proofs of residency required for all residents at registration time**
- **HOCKEY BOOSTER CLUB MEMBERSHIP & U.S.A. HOCKEY INSURANCE**
- Hockey Booster Club Membership \$10.00 per family
- Lottery Fee \$100.00
- U.S.A. Hockey Insurance (applies to ages 7 & up)
- All booster club fees are paid separately to the Garfield Heights Hockey Booster Club

In-House Hockey Program ages 4-12

- This is an affordable introductory program for those who would love to try the game of hockey. This program is divided into 2 10-week sessions, with Session 1 beginning October 1st. Pre-registration is required, all you need is skates & a stick! All necessary protective equipment is provided by the city and hockey booster club.
- All practices and games will be on Saturdays from 11:30 am – 12:30 pm
- If your child does not know how to skate, it is recommended that the you enroll in one of the City's Learn to Skate sessions.
- Fees: \$30.00 Resident + ID card \$10.00
- \$35.00 Non-Resident + ID card \$35.00
