

Garfield Heights In-House Hockey Program **For the Beginning Hockey Player - Ages 3 to 13**

The Garfield Heights Municipal Hockey Program is offering an introductory activity for those who would love to play hockey but have never had the opportunity to try this fast-paced sport.

FEES: \$30.00 residents or \$35.00 non-residents, plus the cost of a Garfield Heights Recreation ID card (\$10.00 residents, \$35.00 non-residents). Proof of residency

(2 forms) is required for residents. This is a ten-week session, which includes a four game “in-house” schedule. Protective equipment will be provided. Player must have own skates and stick.

10 week Session 2: January 7, 14, 21, 28 - February 4, 11, 25 - March 3, 10, and 17
The sessions will be held on Saturdays from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the Dan Kostel Recreation Center Ice Rink in Garfield Heights.

NEW THIS SESSION: This 10 week class is designed for the beginner skater who is interested in playing hockey and *does not know how to skate*. A hockey curriculum will be taught by one of our figure skating professionals on half of the rink.
