WELCOME!

The Garfield Heights Learn to Skate program follows the U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills program guidelines.

The Basic Skills program is designed by U.S. Figure Skating to be the best beginning ice skating program that serves the needs of both recreational and competitive skaters.

REGISTRATION:

All participants must purchase an annual recreation ID card. A resident ID card is \$10.00. A non-resident ID card is \$35.00. This annual card is not only good for the skating programs, but can be used for any other program that the recreation center offers year round, including other sports, lessons & both swimming and skating public sessions. Two (2) proofs of residency are required for all residents at the time of registration & a copy of the child's birth certificate must be brought in at the time of registration for ALL registrations.

Any pre-registered classes missed within a six (6) week session can be made up *WITHIN THAT SESSION ONLY*.

No credits will be given after the session has ended – see office staff for details on how you can make up a missed class.

FEEES FOR SKATING PROGRAM:

It is mandatory for all participants to be pre-registered prior to the beginning of any session and avoid the \$15.00 late fee (no exceptions.)

We will have four (4) six (6) week sessions during our season. Session 1 beginning on Tuesday, September 19th – deadline for signups is on or anytime before Monday, September 18th, as with the remainder of the sessions – deadline for each new session is on or before the Monday before the start of any new session.

Residents - \$30.00 session fee + \$10.00 annual rec ID card = \$40.00

Non-Residents - \$54.00 session fee + \$35.00 annual rec ID card = \$89.00

Skate rental included for all lessons if needed – no additional fee

Private lesson fees on “city ice time” are \$5.00 for our registered many students or \$12.00 for anyone wishing to walk on our city ice, not registered in group lessons. \$10.00 walk on ice is open to everyone, students and instructors from other area rinks are welcome & encouraged to come to our facility.

Save money and purchase punch cards for either city ice or walk on ice & receive 2 free punches.

4:30 pm – 5:15 pm – Pre-freeskate and freeskate – 1 through 5
5:15 pm – 6:00 pm – Snowplow 1, 2, 3 and basic 1 through 6

Wednesdays: **** new in 2017 – walk on ice only – no group scheduled lessons**
2:00 pm – 3:00 pm - \$10.00 walk on ice (subject to weekly changes where additional time may be added – call ahead.

Thursdays: 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm – Private lesson time – City ice
4:00 pm – 4:45 pm – Freeskate 6 and advanced
4:45 pm – 5:30 pm – Pre-freeskate and freeskate 1 through 5
****5:30 pm – 6:00 pm – Clinic**
6:00 pm – 6:45 pm – Snowplow 1, 2, & 3 – Basic 1 through 6
**** Clinic is available to Advanced and Freestyle students registered for the Thursday session at no additional cost.**

All other many students NOT IN the Thursday session wishing to take the Clinic, must pay applicable municipal resident or non-resident fees for the clinic - \$5.00 for Residents - \$9.00 for Non-Residents.

Private Lesson Times and or \$10.00 walk on ice times

All times for \$10.00 walk on & city ice are subject to change especially during early September & the weeks of no scheduled group lessons

There are no scheduled lessons during the following dates – (extra walk on ice/city ice will be available)

Week of October 30 through Nov. 3 (Halloween week)

November 20th through 24th (Thanksgiving week)

December 22nd – no walk on ice (building opening late – legal Holiday for staff)

December 25th through January 1 (Christmas & New Years Holiday week)

Tuesdays: 2:00 pm – 4:30 pm (city ice)

Wednesdays: 2:00 pm – 3:00 pm

Thursdays: 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm (city ice)

Fridays: 2:15 pm – 3:15 pm - \$10.00 walk on session 1

3:15 pm – 4:15 pm - \$10.00 walk on session 2

All students registered in our skating program pay \$5.00 for city ice time or purchase punch card for \$50.00 get 10 punches + 2 free that's a total of 12 punches.

All non-registered skaters pay the \$12.00 walk on fee for city ice time or purchase a punch card for \$120.00 get 10 punches + 2 free that's a total of 12 punches.

Walk on ice is available to everyone registered or not in our program for a fee of \$10.00 per hour - save money & purchase punch card.
