POOL OPENS SATURDAY – JUNE 9, 2018 at 1:00 PM



Beginning on Tuesday, May 29th the office will be open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm for your convenience to purchase season passes and ID cards. The week of June 4th through June 8th our office will be open from 8:00 am – 7:00 pm for everyone's convenience to purchase passes etc. & avoid lines on opening day.

Our pool is open daily 1:00 pm – 7:00 pm (weather permitting)
All children 12 and under MUST be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older AT ALL TIMES! No child under 12 years of age may be left at the pool unattended for any reason. NO SPECTATORS – EVERYONE MUST HAVE A VALID RECREATION ID CARD OR A SEASONS PASS TO ENTER OUR FACILITY.

Please Note: Only an Adult with a recreation ID card, or seasons pass may bring in 1 guest for a fee of \$7.00. The adult must accompany the guest at the pool at all times, and not leave the premises. Parks and Recreation Director/Management reserve the right to refuse admission and/or eject from our facility those who may be under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or those exhibiting erratic behavior. Proper swim attire must be worn at all times. At the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Director, the facility may close due to inclement weather or low pool attendance with no rain checks/refunds due to the parton.

Residents

ID card - \$15.00 (allows entering pool for a reduced admission fee)

Season Passes - (no additional fees with seasons passes)

Student – \$45.00 – age 5 – 17

Adult - \$55.00 – age 18 – 64

Family Pass - \$110.00 – 2 parents 2 dependent children

Additional dependent children residing in the household - \$10.00 each

Non-Residents

ID card - \$40.00 (allows entering pool for a reduced admission fee)

Season Passes – (no additional fees with seasons passes)

Student - \$160.00 – age 5 – 17

Adult - \$190.00 – age 18 – 64

Family Pass - \$370.00 – 2 parents 2 dependent children

Additional dependent children in the residing in the household - \$10.00 each

Only a parent or legal guardian can purchase Passes, ID cards and register children for Learn to swim classes.

Birth certificates are required for all Season Pass, ID card purchases and all registrations. Residents need to bring 2 current utility bills, bank statements, pay stub for proof of residency, at the time of registration

No exceptions.

LEARN TO SWIM CLASSES

More detailed information coming soon to this web page regarding lessons & registration - we will begin taking registrations Monday, June 18th for Session 1 which will begin on July 9th with deadline July 6th by 4:00 pm

Lessons are held Monday through Thursday, for the 2 week session (8 lessons) Children must be 5 years of age to take the above lessons, birth certificate required at the time of registration. The Parks & Recreation Director reserves the right to cancel any classes with an enrollment of less than 6 participants however every attempt will be made to accommodate all participants by combining classes if necessary.

Fees for Learn to Swim Classes

Residents – 8 lessons = \$40.00 + \$15.00 current ID card = \$55.00

Non-Residents - 8 lessons = \$80.00 + \$40.00 current ID card = \$120.00
