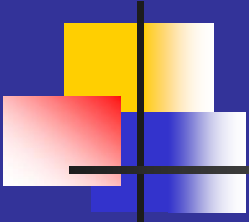

# YOUTH TRAVEL HOCKEY FEES

- 
- A recreation card must be purchased
    - Residents ID \$10.00 – Non-Residents ID - \$35.00
  - Under 8 years of age – Residents \$150.00
  - Under 8 years of age – Non-Residents \$260.00
  - 8 years of age or over – Residents \$200.00
  - 8 years of age or over – Non-Residents \$460.00
  - **2 proofs of residency required for all residents at registration time**
  - **HOCKEY BOOSTER CLUB MEMBERSHIP & U.S.A. HOCKEY INSURANCE**
  - Hockey Booster Club Membership \$60.00
  - Lottery Fee (10 tickets per family) \$100.00
  - U.S.A. Hockey Insurance mandatory & applies to children ages 7 & up paid separately \$45.00
  - Additional fees for jerseys, socks and mite equipment rental will be assessed.
  
  - All booster club fees are paid separately to the Garfield Heights Hockey Booster Club
  - Separate payment in the form of check, credit card, or cash to the Booster Club.

# 2017 SPECIAL REGISTRATION DATES & TIMES

- Registration will begin on Monday, July 10, 2017 during any of our open office hours. Please note that during our swimming season we do have extended evening and weekends that you can register your child. We will also have 1 Saturday set aside for your convenience where the booster club will be here to take booster club membership registrations

**Saturday - July 22<sup>nd</sup> -12:30 pm – 4:00 pm**

After the pool closes on August 13<sup>th</sup> we will have limited office hours Monday through Friday only with no weekend or evening hours available, while we prep our rink for season opening, where it may not be as convenient for you. So register your child early, after September 8<sup>th</sup> there will be a \$15.00 late fee (for all past players –no exceptions).

**Your child must be registered prior to taking the ice.**

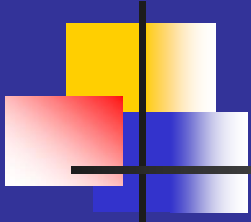
**If your child comes to practice & is not registered, there will be a \$10.00 non-refundable walk on fee, each time they go on the ice & up until they are registered.**

**Avoid all additional fees & register early.**

# In-House Hockey Program

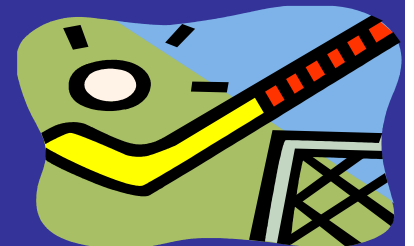
## ages 3-13

You can experience hockey and learn how to skate, in an eight (8) week session which will include use of necessary protective equipment. All you need is skates and a stick. Not sure if you want to register your child.....Come and join us on Saturday, September 16<sup>th</sup> for tryout/orientation day FREE OF CHARGE! If you need skates, rental skates will be available at no charge, and then if your child likes it – the office will be open for you to register your child and receive the equipment so you can start on September 23<sup>rd</sup>. On Saturday, December 2<sup>nd</sup> we will have tryout/orientation day for Session 2, which begins on January 6, 2018, the deadline for Session 2 without late fee will be Thursday, December 28<sup>th</sup> due to the holidays.

Take advantage of the FREE tryout days. Avoid the late fee of \$15.00 and register on or before the deadline dates of either session.
