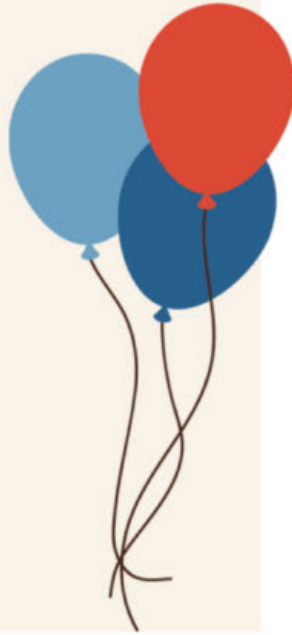

SENIOR RECIPE

HONEY BUTTER SKILLET CORNBREAD

1c. flour,	1/2c. butter
spooned and leveled	1/4c. vegetable oil
1/4c. yellow cornbread	1c. sugar
1/2tsp. salt	1/3c. honey
1/2tsp. baking soda	2 large eggs
2tsp. baking powder	1-1/4c. buttermilk

Preheat oven to **375F**. Place your 9in. cast iron skillet in oven while it preheats. In a small bowl, combine flour, cornmeal, salt, baking soda, and baking powder.

Cut off about 1/2 tbsp. of the 1/2 butter and set aside to grease the pan later. Melt the remaining butter in large microwave safe bowl.

Add vegetable oil, sugar and honey to the bowl with the melted butter. Stir until combined.

Add eggs and buttermilk, whisk until smooth.

Stir the dry ingredients in, using wooden spoon or spatula, just until combined. Be sure to not over mix, there will be some lumps remaining.

Remove cast iron skillet from oven. Grease the bottom and sides with the set aside butter, use pastry brush if needed.

Pour batter into the hot pan and smooth the top.

Place skillet back into oven and bake 28-32 minutes, until toothpick comes out clean. Top will be golden brown, and edges slightly pulled away from pan. Let cool 5-10 minutes before slicing. Top with extra butter and honey for serving.

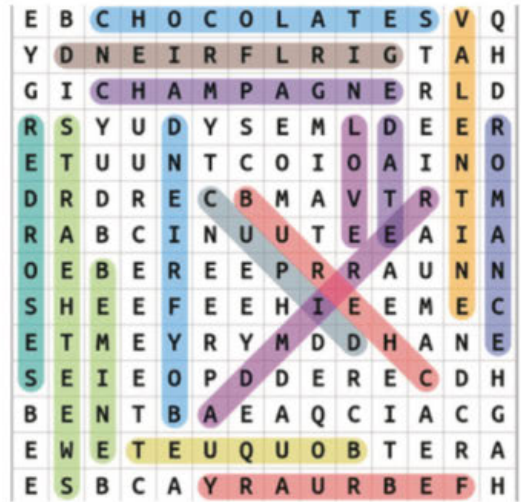
