Tuesday, June 24th @ 9:45am







ALL CLASS REUNION MONDAY, JUNE 30TH



NO BAKE BANANA SPLIT CAKE

Ingredients:

2 cups graham cracker crumbs	¾ cup white sugar
8 Tbsp. unsalted butter, melted	16 oz. cream cheese,
softened	
1 ½ cups powdered sugar	4 bananas sliced
20 oz. crushed pineapple, drained	¼ cup peanuts coarsely
chopped	
16 ounce frozen whipped topping, thawed	15 maraschino cherries

Instructions:

1. In a food processor, pulse the graham crackers until finely chopped.
2. In a large bowl, stir together the graham cracker crumbs, white sugar, and melted butter until combined.
3. Press into the bottom of a 9x13 inch baking dish in a flat layer.
4. Refrigerate until set.
5. In a medium bowl, beat together the cream cheese and powdered sugar until well blended.
6. Spread the cream cheese mixture in an even layer over the graham cracker crust.
7. Over the cream cheese layer, place the bananas and pineapple in even layers.
8. Cover the top with a layer of whipped topping.
9. Top the dessert with chopped nuts and cherries.
10. Refrigerate until completely chilled. Serve cold.


